

Declaration By A Permanent Resident

First Home Owner Grant Act 2000 Western Australia

It is a requirement under section 10 of the First Home Owner Grant Act 2000 that **at least one applicant** for a grant is an Australian citizen or a permanent resident.

A permanent resident is –

- (a) A person who is –
 - (i) the holder of a permanent visa within the meaning of section 30 of the Migration Act 1958 of the Commonwealth; or
 - (ii) a New Zealand citizen who is the holder of a special category visa within the meaning of section 32 of the Migration Act 1958 of the Commonwealth;
- and
- (b) has satisfied the Commissioner that he or she intends to reside permanently in Australia.

This declaration forms part of the First Home Owner Grant application and when completed will assist the Commissioner to be satisfied that the applicant intends to reside permanently in Australia.

The declaration is only necessary where none of the applicants are Australian citizens.
